  - 3. Parents will participate on site-based committees, such as school improvement, literacy, and math. (Leslie Dunn, District Parent Coordinator, Derek Snelson-Parent, Mary Goad-Parent, Dennis Mannon-Grandparent, Kathy Mannon-Grandparent)
  - 4. A needs assessment will be conducted at the building level to determine degree of needs. The list of needs will be compiled and distributed to parents. (Leslie Dunn, District Parent Coordinator)
  - 5. Parents will be surveyed regarding their abilities and interests as volunteers provided in the informational packets. Staff will be encouraged to use the surveys. (Leslie Dunn, District Parent Coordinator)
  - 6. Parent volunteers will participate in the development and implementation of the Parental Involvement Plan. (Derek Snelson-Parent, Mary Goad-Parent, Dennis Mannon-Grandparent, Kathy Mannon-Grandparent)
  - 7. Information about student performance activities such as plays, concerts, and athletic events will be provided for parents so that parents will have the opportunity to attend the activities. (Principal Patti Stevens)
- B. Parent kits containing pertinent school information will be furnished to each parent. Each kit will contain the following:
  - 1. School/district calendar
  - 2. Description of school's Parent Involvement Program
  - 3. Contact information for parents about each school
  - 4. Location of helpful parent materials
  - 5. Hours and location of parent center
  - 6. Recommended role of the parent, student, teacher, and school
  - 7. School telephone number, e-mail address, and school web-page address
  - 8. Dates of two parent/teacher conferences to be held each year
  - 9. Guidelines and procedures for parent visitation

C. Activities and Events

1. Open House will be held August 13, 2015 from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. They will be shown where their classes will be held, and, if possible, meet all their teachers.
2. Two parent/teacher conferences have been scheduled

D. School Policies
