Dear Parent or Guardian,

Bradford School District's AMI (Alternative Method of Instruction) Plan has been approved by the Arkansas Department of Education. This means that instead of days missed for events such as inclement weather being added to the end of the school year once testing is over, students will complete work from home on the AMI days not in school. The work will be focused on a review of concepts that the child has been taught and will be sent home in advance when possible.

Student attendance in elementary on these days will be recorded in this way:

- Students who complete the assignments AND return the assignments to school within two school days will be counted present.
- Students who do not complete the assignments AND return the assignments to school within two school days will be counted absent.

You will receive the packet of work from your child's teacher in advance when possible. Please read the packet carefully. Incomplete or missing work will affect the child's grade.
